Request for humanitarian assistance and support for Kharkiv residents

Dear Sir/Madame,

We appeal to you and all the citizens of Poznan on behalf of the Youth Council under Kharkiv City Mayor and all citizens of the city who need help of various kinds.

We are a nonprofit organization which in pre-war times created 1000 free projects which developed the youth and the city. Now already more than 40 days we are engaged in voluntary work which aspires at least on a minimal level to support the vital activity of the city dwellers who have remained in Kharkiv.

Nevertheless, without your support and our cooperation in the current circumstances, it is very difficult to cope.

Our organization has three main areas of working:

- Targeted delivery of baby food, diapers, medicine, and food kits to children and mothers;
- Targeted delivery of food kits to pensioners;
- General system of work for more than 30 volunteer organizations to maintain a unified system of referrals and optimize resources for effective assistance.

Our team consists of 70 people who handle from **1,000 to 2,000 requests for help every day**. For almost 2 months of the war, we have collected about **100,000 euros** and provided assistance to more than **27,000 Kharkiv citizens** thanks to the humanitarian and financial aid we have received.

We see and feel all the support Poznan has already provided for Ukraine and are thankful to You. Currently, Kharkiv city and its residents are in a deep need of your support to be able to have access to the first-need supplies, which are hard to obtain solely under shelling or missile strikes. We believe that with the help of You, as a youth and citizens of Poznan, we would be able to cover more needs of children, elderly people, and adults in these difficult times. If possible, we would be grateful for any support in areas of critical need, in any way that is available to you.

We are ready to send you regular reports in a format convenient for you, to facilitate the development of trusting relationships and to publicize your assistance to the Kharkiv citizens.
